

<u>Instrumental Lessons – 2017-18</u>

Dear Parent/Guardian

At Saint George we are able to offer a wide range of instrumental and vocal lessons. Instrumental tuition is a fantastic opportunity and can richly increase your child's experience and enjoyment of school. We are able to offer woodwind, brass, string, drum kit, bass, vocal, piano, keyboard and guitar lessons.

Lessons are 30 minutes long and are 1:1, with the exception of guitar lessons, which can be 1:1 or in small groups (no more than four). The cost of instrumental tuition is £120 a term, totalling £360 for the year. Group lessons (only available for guitar) are £90 a term or £270 for the year.

Payments may be made either online, via cheque or cash by the **10**th **September 2017** in order for your child to start their lessons. You can make one payment for the full year or termly instalments:

Term 1 £120 by 10th September 2017 Term 2 £120 by 12th January 2018 Term 3 £120 by 20th April 18

If your child is already having instrumental lessons at primary school, and they wish to continue when they come here to St George, please **tick & sign** the terms and conditions by 17th July 2017 and return to Miss Bishop, together with payment for the autumn term fees. Equally, if your child would like to start learning an instrument then please get in touch with Mrs Pegg (Head of music) this term via email or phone (Wednesdays to Fridays).

Terms and Conditions of Instrumental lessons St George Catholic VA College
• Instrumental lessons will take place within the college day, lessons will last for 30 minutes. The time of

- of the lesson will rotate each week to minimise the impact on other subjects.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they arrive promptly for each lesson.
- It is important that the student comes to the lesson prepared, having practised and with the correct book/material and instrument.
- A register is maintained to monitor attendance. Instrumental teachers will email you if your child is absent from a lesson. Your child is also required to sign this upon arrival and will be kept on file
- You will receive information from the instrumental teacher about your son/daughters progress each term on mentoring days.
- The fee is calculated on 33 lessons per college year although students may receive more than this at no extra charge (the college year is 39 weeks). This also allows for bank holidays and college closures. Should a student not receive a minimum of 33 lessons per year due to the instrumental teacher not being available, a refund will be made. Please note that we do not refund lessons if your child is off sick or absent from school.

- Payment for instrumental lessons must be made before each term starts, for example; spring term payment must be made by the last day of the autumn term. Students who wish to start lessons midterm need to contact the college, and subject to availability. Payments can be made online or via the college finance office, cheques made payable to Southampton City Council.
- Should your child have exams/tests which coincide with their music tuition, we will endeavour to change the time of their instrumental lesson, but will require at least one week's notice to do this.
- The timetable for instrumental lessons is displayed on the notice board in the music dept. Student's should check the notice board on the morning of their lesson in case it has been necessary to change the time of the lesson. Any change in day (this happens rarely), students will be notified by the instrumental teacher one week in advance.
- There is a storage room within the music dept to store instruments, the instruments should be put into this area upon arrival at college in the morning, and collected in time for their lesson. The instrument will then be returned to the storage room to be collected and taken home at the end of the college day.
- Communication with parents will be made either by letter, email or telephone. Please ensure that the college holds your up to date information.
- Group tuition will be for groups of 2-4 students for guitar only. The instrumental teacher will decide the size of the group and this will be on matching the ability of students.
- Your child's instrumental teacher will encourage entry into graded examinations when they are ready, an additional fee will be required for each examination.

• The college has many ensembles and activities within the Music Department, and we will encourage

your child to attend.

I understand that the college cannot accept liability for any loss or damage to an instrument. I accept that it is my responsibility to ensure that my child's instrument is covered by my household insurance.

I agree that my email address may be shared with my son/daughter's instrumental teacher.

I understand that if I decide to cancel the arrangements for instrumental lessons, I must give at least one full term's notice, otherwise I agree to pay the cost of those lessons already arranged. ** You will receive an email to confirm we have received a full term's notice.
