Monday 29 <sup>th</sup> January 2018	Letter out to all year 9 pupils inviting them to our curriculum information evening on Thursday 2 <sup>nd</sup> February 2018 7pm – Main Hall.
Thursday 22 <sup>nd</sup> February 2018	<p>Year 9 Curriculum Information Evening – 7pm Main Hall Information to be given for forthcoming options process and any curriculum changes.</p> <p>Careers Fair – College Canteen – Apprenticeships – 7:45pm</p>
Monday 26 <sup>th</sup> February 2018	Year 9 Exams week (Majority of subjects)
Monday 12 <sup>th</sup> March 2018	Deadline for teachers of option subjects to complete a Predicted Grade for each pupil for End of Key Stage Four.
Tuesday 13 <sup>th</sup> March 2018	<p>Mr Habberley will then process pupils predicted grades for their option subjects against their target grades and select their three highest performing subjects.</p> <p>All pupils will continue to study 1 Humanities subject either History or Geography or a modern foreign language in order to maximise their results in year 11. A percentage of pupils will be guided into continuing with both a language and a humanities subject if they took it in year 9 to achieve the overall EBACC qualification providing they can achieve their target grade.</p> <p>Please note that a small group of pupils currently studying do BTEC Level 2 Hospitality instead. Pupils will be guided into these options if it's felt it will improve their overall grades.</p> <p>Mr Habberley builds Class Lists based on provisional subjects into year 10.</p>
